As I mentioned, JSSD is willing to pay the costs associated with its GRAMA request, although it was my understanding we'd start in the following manner to avoid excessive costs. First, you indicated you'll need to print off copies of all records (approx'y 1,000 pages at .25/page). You'll then need to redact certain information relating to your claim that person(s) have asked for anonymity. This would cost approximately \$30/hour for the staff person. At that point, we were going to review the records, to determine what if any of it we actually want. We may want it all, or we may just take a portion of what is being produced. We agreed to take this approach so we can maintain the integrity of the Auditor's files, including its work papers.

Based on the foregoing, we don't see that the costs should be more than \$500, although understand it may be more. We'd like to keep the costs to a minimum.
