Mike Moffitt suggests to strike out the words "arranged by a transferring physician for a particular patient" and replace with: "Inter-facility transfer" means an ambulance transfer of a patient who does not have an emergency condition as defined as in UCA 26-8A-1026A and the ambulance transfer of the patient is from a hospital, nursing facility, patient receiving facility, mental health facility or other licensed medical facility.
