## Utah Bureau of Emergency Medical Services Non-Emergency Secure Behavioral Health Patient Transport Vehicle Requirements

- \* Physical barrier to restrict any direct contact between person transported and the vehicle operator.
- \* Secured gurney and manufacturer's recommended retention system.
- \* First aid kit includes:
  - (4) Antiseptic Towelettes
  - (16) Plastic Bandage Strips 1" x 3"
  - (1) Roll of Sterile Gauze 2" x 5 yd.
  - (6) Gauze Pads 2" x 2"
  - (1) Roll of Adhesive Tape 1/2" x 5 yd.
  - (1) Non-Sterile Triangle Bandage
  - (1) Small, Ice Pack
- \* Automated External Defibrillator
- \* Secured oxygen supply for duration of the transport
- \* 1 Biohazard bag
- \* 1 Box of latex free gloves
- \* Disinfecting agent for cleaning vehicle and equipment of bodily fluids in accordance with OSHA standards of bleach diluted between 1:10 and 1:100 with water or equivalent.
- \* Personal Protective Equipment (goggles or face shields and gloves), one for each crew member.
- \* Fire extinguisher, operational and with a current inspection sticker, of the dry chemical type with a rating of 2A10BC.
- \* Any additional medical supplies require an approved waiver by the Department.
- \* Staff will have completed and provide proof of training from at least one of the following:
  - 1. Steward Healthcare formerly-IASIS is- CPI
  - 2. Salt Lake Behavioral is- MANDT System
  - 3. University of Utah Healthcare is- HOPE
