Utah Airport Revitalization Grant Opportunity - Brief

Utah Department of Transportation - Division of Aeronautics

Summary

Utah's Division of Aeronautics is happy to announce the Utah Airport Revitalization Grant as a new annual funding opportunity to support the visual aspect of airport facilities and grounds. The grant is open to public use airports in the State of Utah. This grant does not take away or add to any existing (ACIP) Airport Capital Improvement Plans, or (ALP) Airport Layout Plans. Those are other avenues set up by the FAA and State of Utah for funding opportunities. Awardees will receive funding on an agreed payment schedule based on selected projects. \$200,000 is the total amount of funds the Division of Aeronautics has each year to be allocated. The goal of this grant is to support multiple small projects at airports while enhancing their visibility and aesthetics.

Requirements

To be considered, the airport sponsor must complete the Utah Airport Revitalization Grant Application located in Blackcat, which should include:

- (1) A project that meets the intent of the Revitalization Grant Opportunity that supports restoration or improvement to an airport.
- (2) Includes a detailed description of the project, why this project will meet the requirements, and duration of the project.
- (3) A sponsor or partner that will help share portions of the cost.
- (4) Discussion of the impact to users on the airport air-side and land-side.
- (5) A location map of the project.
- (6) Itemized list of supplies or equipment needed, and itemized project cost.
- (7) Desired payment schedule.

All awardees will have the opportunity to justify or negotiate their project needs and address any questions or concerns to the grant requirements.

Timeline

The grant application opens at the beginning of each Fiscal Year, starting July 1. Proposals will then be reviewed by the Division of Aeronautics and approved projects will be notified on a quarterly basis. Fund schedules will be negotiated and outlined prior to approved notices. Awardees will, in writing, report on project progress and outcomes on a bi-weekly basis during the project.
