
Slow Down, 5 Miles Per Hour Over Makes A Big Difference

Imagine driving in a 70 mph speed zone at 70 mph and you see an obstacle just in time to stop. What would happen if you were traveling just 5 mph faster?

Speeding-related deaths nationwide account for nearly a third of all traffic fatalities each year, taking close to 10,000 lives.



For every 10 mph over 50 mph, the risk of death in a crash is DOUBLED 40%

Speed was a factor in 40 percent of Utah's FATAL CRASHES
