REJECT - ON FILE

- Record being entered is already on file
 - Only one record with the same type of entry and the same ORI and OCA may be entered

REJECT - ON FILE

- 1. Record being entered is already on file.
- 2. Transaction attempts to modify an identifier in one record to the same identifier already on file in another record.

When the above message is received, the record on file is included in the response.





REJECT - NOT ON FILE

- An identifier(s) used to identify a record in a maintenance transaction is in error; therefore, the record on file was not found.
- Persons the name has to match exactly when you are trying to modify

REJECT - ON FILE

- Record being entered is already on file.
- Transaction attempts to modify an identifier in one record to the same identifier already on file in another record.

When the above message is received, the record on file is included in the response.





ACCURACY OF NCIC RECORDS

- Entering agency is responsible for the accuracy of the records
- Second Party Checks
 - Document when it's done






TIMELINESS OF NCIC RECORDS

- Wanted Person
 - Entered immediately after the decision to arrest or authorize arrest has been made
- Missing Person
 - As soon as possible once the minimum data is available and the record documentation is available
 - Under 21 record should be entered with 2 hours
- Article, Boat, Gun, License Plate, Securities, Vehicle/Boat Part and Vehicle Files
 - As soon as possible once the minimum data is available.
 - Stolen Lic plates and vehicles should be verified through the appropriate motor vehicle registration prior to entry if available if not, then as soon as possible

TIMELY NCIC ENTRY

- Hae Min Lee
- Missing January 13, 1999
- Reported missing she was entered into NCIC early January 14, 1999
 - Vehicle was missing also, but it wasn't entered into NCIC
- Vehicle was inquired on:
 - Twice on Jan 14, 1999
 - Jan 15, 1999
 - Jan 29, 1999



• Twice on Jan 4, 1999

 Was actually entered into NCIC on Feb. 10, 1999







TIMELY MODIFICATION

- Occurs as soon as possible following the detection of erroneous data
- As soon as possible following the receipt of data not already stored in the record





TIMELY INQUIRY

- Initiated before an officer begins writing an arrest or citation document of any kind
- Prior to the release of a person who has been incarcerated
- Inquiry is made upon those who appear at a custodial facility to visit inmates





TIMELY LOCATE

- Once the record has been confirmed with the entering agency
- Locate will add the following:
 - ORI of locating agency
 - Date and time of locate
- Wanted Person will indicate if they are being detained, extradited, or no extradition
- Entering agency should clear or cancel the entry after a locate has been received
- Missing Person will delete the record, the entering agency will be notified by a \$.L. message
- Other files will stay on system for 10 days then will be purged





TIME REMOVAL

- Immediate removal of the record once you have documentation that the fugitive has been arrested or is no longer wanted
- When the property has been verified that it is recovered
- After a locate has been placed on the entry





COMPLETENESS

- · All available information on the person or property at the time of entry
- Critical information is:
 - Data fields that will
 - 1) increase the likelihood of a positive hit on the subject or property
 - 2) assist in compliance with applicable laws and requirements
- Persons -
 - Social Security number
 - Passport numbers
 - VIN; Lic Plate;
 - Driver's Lic
 - Any numbers that could be indexed in the record
- Vehicles
 - VIN
 - IIC.





QUALITY CONTROL

- Serious Errors
 - Wanted Person records that indicate the person is wanted for questioning only
 - Entries with incorrect data
 - Records entered that shouldn't go into the NCIC files such as cashier's checks, bank drafts, bank officer's check, stolen credit cards, personal checks, etc.





QUALITY CONTROL

- Serious Errors
 - A record with inaccurate data
 - Records entered in the wrong file
 - Property records with a non-unique number
 - Property records entered with generic codes





NAME MATCHING FOR INQUIRIES

- Use the New York State Identification and Intelligence System (NYSIIS)
- If the Nam and DOB are used primary hits are determined by using a phonetic encoding of the last name and an exact match on the month, day and year of birth
- If the given name corresponds to a list of nicknames it is replaced by the proper name
 - Bill is replaced by William
 - Betty is replaced by Elizabeth
- Hyphenated Names use each part of the hyphenated as a last name as well as all combinations of the hyphenated name parts





NAME MATCHING FOR INQUIRIES

- Expanded Name Search
 - Will treat all parts of the name as a last name
 - Bryan, Lee Morgan
 - Lee, Bryan Morgan
 - Morgan, Lee Bryan
 - Lee, Morgan Bryan
 - Lee, Bryan Morgan





DELAYED INQUIRIES

- Inquiries are stored for 5 days
- During the 5 days entries and modification messages are checked against the logs
- If a match occurs both the entering agency and the inquiring agency will receive a \$.H. message
 - \$.H. Delayed Inquiry Notification
 - \$.H. Delayed Inquiry Hit Response

WANTED PERSONS

- Common Errors
- Reject on File When trying to do an entry
 - Trying to enter the same person that is already entered by your agency
 - Only one entry per agency
 - Additional warrants modify to add data in the Additional Warrants field
 - Put additional warrants in the MISC field








WANTED PERSONS

- Detainers
 - May be filed when a person is being held by another agency
 - So the person won't be released without the other agency being notified








DETAINER

- Entry must be in "Located" status
- If the locating agency intends to hold the individual on local charges
- The entering agency may add a detainer within 5 days of the locate transaction
- Allows the record to remain in NCIC until extradition can occur







DETAINER

- Only one detainer may be attached to the entry
- The incarcerating agency will be notified by a \$.O. msg advising that a detainer has been filed
- Five days prior to the date of sentence expiration the ORI will receive a \$.P. notification – reminder of the subjects pending release
- Contact the incarcerating agency



WANTED PERSONS

- May enter Temporary Wanted
- A temporary felony want record will be retired at the end of 48 hours, and a \$.P. administrative message will be sent to the originating agency








MISSING PERSONS - PERSON WITH INFORMATION

- Person With Information
- Only used with Endangered or Involuntary
- Maximum of two PWI records
- PWI requires review after 72 hours
- Additional review after 30 days and then again every 30 thereafter
- Use the NIC and OCA to enter the MMP1








PERSON WITH INFORMATION

- Conditions that must exist to enter a PWI
- MP was last seen under circumstances that pose a risk to their safety
- "substantial likelihood" the PWI has information that would result in the recovery of the MP
- The PWI has relevant information that will assist the LE agency to locate the MP

- The PWI cannot be located and time is of the essence
- The identity of the PWI has been disclosed to the general public through an Amber Alert or other notification











OFF LINE SEARCHES

- Include a date range if applicable
- Can search any of the fields, not just searchable fields

- Oklahoma Bombing April 19, 1995
- Task force requests all information about Timothy McVeigh
- Off-line search indicated that on April 15, 1995, 90 minutes after the bombing Timothy McVeigh was inquired on by the Oklahoma Highway Patrol
- Determined the inquiry was because of a traffic stop
- Timothy McVeigh was being held on a weapons charge
- Able to arrest Timothy McVeigh while he was in custody because of this information

\$.K. – MISSING INFORMATION NOTIFICATION

- Missing Information Notification is sent to the ORI of record
- Missing Person entry or Unidentified entry
- If the entry is over 30 days
 - Missing data from Blood Type, Dental Characteristics, Fingerprint Classifications, Jewelry Type, Scars, Marks and Tattoos
 - Or the Height or Weight has "UNK"
- Review the data for additional information, possibly contact the family etc.
- Use the NCIC Missing Person File Data Collection Entry Guide
 - Gina McNeil at gmcneil@Utah.gov or Law Enforcement Enterprise Portal (LEEP)
- Add any additional information to the entry



 - If a "Y" code is used it will search for any article with that serial or OAN
 - You could get many hits








INVESTIGATIVE INTEREST
