my size.*

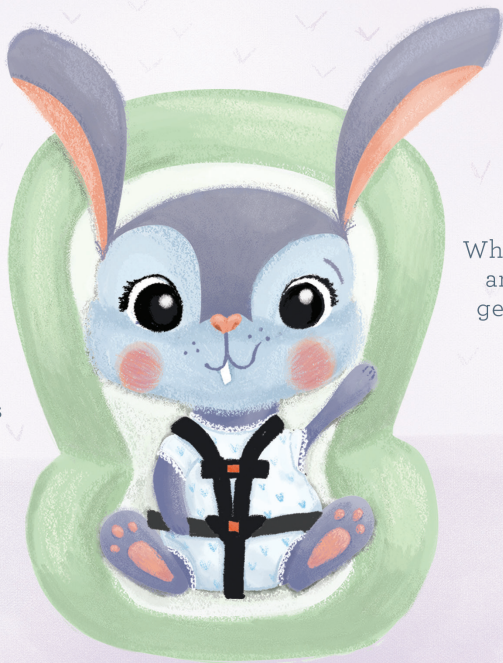


*But some things are

*Hi! I'm Otter.*

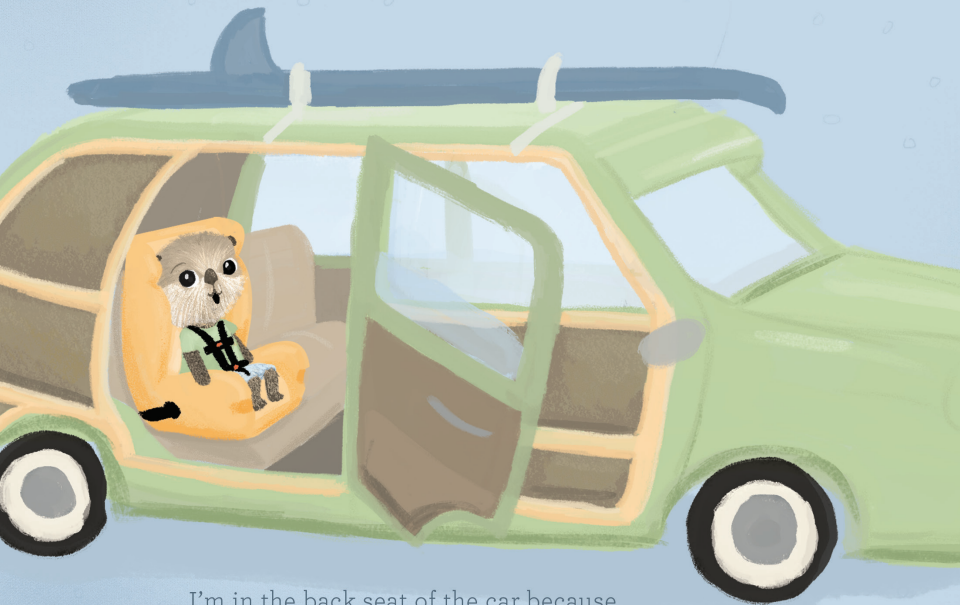


*I'll be starting preschool next year.*

what size they are,*

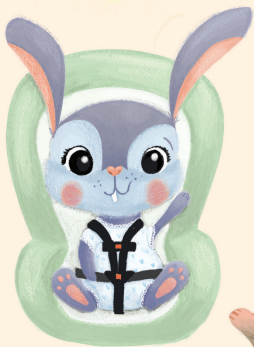
I don't need a
