Program Description:

Antelope Island Ranch Volunteers assist the Park Curator in conducting educational and interpretive programs to the visitors. We offer daily hands on activities during the summer months. Some limited programming is offered during the winter months.

Responsibilities and Duties:

- Assist Park Curator or other Volunteer / Ranch Staff with program development, including scheduling programs and events.
- Assist with leading and conducting guided ranch tours.
- Provide hands on activities to the ranch visitors.
- Provide meet and greet to ranch visitors.
- Assist Park Curator with Guided historical hikes.
- Assist Park Curator with historical research on island.
- Informing guests of programs/events happening within the park.
- Provide general maintenance for the Ranch.

- Able to work in a variety of settings, terrain, and weather conditions with people of diverse backgrounds.
- Able to work with children and adults.
- Dependability – willing to commit to and follow through on assigned duties and programs.
