

New Construction!

As part of our partnership with the Bureau of Reclamation, we are working on Phase II Rehabilitation projects. Phase I included the revamping of the park entrance at Hailstone. A few of the projects include rehabilitating the beach area from the Beach House to Cabana 1, expansion of trailer/boat storage by the storage buildings, boat

maintenance shop, parking, paddleboard storage,

classroom/vendor building at PWC, installation of a new pavilion and 2 more cabanas, upgrades to Keetley group campsite, gray water wash stations, and more! We are stretching the money as best we can!

Don't Spread the Mussels!

During the winter months, you must dry for 30 days (or 3 consecutive days in freezing temps) to be considered *dry*.

Where We Began

In 1957, a new Utah State Parks Commission came into being through the efforts of the state legislature and Governor George Dewey Clyde. The legislature tasked the commission with formulating and executing a long-range plan for a state park and recreation system.

The park is open for day use every day from 6am to 10pm. Day use at Hailstone is now \$7/car or \$4/car for Utah seniors. Self-contained camping is available in the marina lot for \$16/night. Hike-in camping is available at Rock Cliff for \$10/night.

Utah State Parks Ice Safety Tips

- Test the ice. Drill a hole close to shore to determine ice thickness. People should stay off the ice if it is two inches or less. Ice four inches thick will typically hold the weight of a person.

- Always carry ice picks and a life jacket. If you fall through, ice picks provide grip and traction allowing you to pull yourself out of the water. A lifejacket keeps you afloat if you can't self-rescue.

- Stay calm. If you do fall through the ice, remain calm and keep your head above water and control your breathing. Keep all clothing on to stay insulated. Swim towards the ice opening and use your ice picks to secure and pull yourself out.

- Reach, throw and don't go. If someone falls in, reach something to the victim like a ski pole or tree branch; throw a rope or extension cord; don't create a second victim.

-Dress for weather conditions and layer your clothing.

State Parks Reservations

• Reservations can be made by phone and online: <u>stateparks.utah.gov</u> or call 800-322-3770.

• Reservations for individual sites can be made 16 weeks (4 months) in advance of your arrival date. Group sites can be reserved 11 months in advance.
