

Fundamentals of PROW ADA Ramp Design, Layout, Inspection and Construction

Tuesday, April 19, 8 am – 5 pm (Will break for lunch on your own) Fee: \$65

In this full day course, participants will receive a certification of course completion for "Fundamentals of Public Rights-of-Way (PROW) ADA Accessibility Design, Layout, Inspection, and Construction." This course involves discussion of the major design assistance documents available for properly planning, designing, and constructing accessibility features in the public way. Actual layout of curb cut assemblies will be a major topic of discussion, including a step-by-step process. Workshop topics include ADA history, enforcement of ADA, transition plans, 2011 PROW Proposed Accessibility Guidelines, APWA and UDOT Standards, 2007 Special Report on Accessible Public Rights-of-Way layout of curb cut assemblies, and lessons learned from practical experience.

Roadway Drainage

Wednesday April 20, 8 am – 12 pm

Fee: \$45

Instruction includes identifying legal issues associated with drainage, reviewing roadway and drainage fundamentals, troubleshooting road drainage problems, alternatives to replacing culverts, some ways to solve problems without replacing existing culverts, types of culverts, how to determine culvert size, how to install culverts, roadside safety issues, ditching, examining principles and processes of erosion and understanding basic erosion control measures.

ATSSA Flagger Certification

Wednesday, April 20, 8 am – 12 pm

Fee: \$45 *Must be 18 years of age or older*

This state-specific flagger training is recommended for all roadway workers, contractors, law enforcement and supervisors. This is a basic course that prepares each worker to handle the responsibilities associated with Utah highway flagger responsibilities as outlined in Part 6 of the MUTCD. In the course, each worker will be required to take a short exam and demonstrate their understanding of the rules covering a flagger through a mockup of a traffic control situation. ATSSA Certification card will be issued to those who pass the exam. Certification is good for 3 years.

ATSSA Traffic Control Technician (TCT)

Thursday, April 21, 8 am – 4 pm

Fee: \$125

The Traffic Control technician course is offered as an introduction to the basic principles of temporary work zone traffic control. This one-day training course is designed to instruct the participants in the underlying principles of temporary traffic control as set forth in the MUTCD. Students will be provided with practical knowledge, techniques, and instruction on the installation and maintenance of traffic control devices to enable them to apply practical concepts. The Utah LTAP Center is recommending this course for all workers which may be required to handle temporary traffic control devices and is accepted by UDOT as a Traffic Control Maintainer. Workers are required to complete a written examination and will receive a certificate of completion from ATSSA. Training is good for 4 years. NOTE: It will take **6-8 weeks for certificates** to be mailed.
