

WIC (Women, Infants & Children)

WIC is a supplemental food and nutrition program for Women, Infants, and Children (WIC). Pregnant women, new mothers, and young children may be provided healthy foods, nutrition counseling, and breastfeeding support. Eligibility is determined by family size and household gross income. If you are pregnant, your unborn child is considered a member of your family. To qualify you must:

- Live in Weber or Morgan County
- Be pregnant, breastfeeding, or just had a baby or have an infant or child under 5 years of age
- Need WIC foods to be healthy
- Meet income guidelines or be receiving Medicaid or food stamps.

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Vital Records

Birth Certificates: Available for all Utah births from 1951–present; for Ogden City from 1909–present.

Death Certificates: Available for all Utah deaths from 2006–present; Weber County and Ogden City from 1958–present; Morgan County 1993–present

Divorce Records: Available for all Utah divorces from 1978-2010

Marriage Records: Available for all Utah marriages except Weber County from 1978 to 2010; Weber County records obtained at Weber County Clerk/Auditor Office, 2380 Washington Blvd, Ogden UT 84401

Cancer Screening for Women: Breast exam and pap smear. Vouchers given for mammograms and, if needed, physician follow-up. Free for women ages 40–64. Clinic operates by appointment only.

Be Wise: Free cardiovascular risk screening and counseling to low-income, underinsured, or uninsured women ages 40–64.

Immunizations: Reduced cost for required childhood vaccinations if the child is uninsured or under-insured. Pricing for all other vaccinations including travel vaccines is based on cost of vaccine plus administration charge. Clinic operates by appointment only.

TB Testing: Clinic operates Monday through Wednesday by appointment only. Cost is price of test plus administration charge.

STD/HIV Testing (Sexually Transmitted Diseases/AIDS):

No parental consent for minors needed; all information is strictly confidential. Testing for chlamydia, gonorrhea, and syphilis only – no exam. Free HIV testing in June and December. Clinic operates by appointment only.

Blood Pressure: Clinic operates Monday through Friday. 8:30 am to 11:30 am and 1:00 pm to 5:00 pm. (No fee)

Pregnancy Testing: Clinic operates Monday through Friday by appointment only. Cost is price of test plus administration charge.

Baby Your Baby: Presumptive eligibility to Medicaid for pregnant women. Call for program information and appointment.



Target Case Management: Home visits by Registered Nurses serving children ages 0–3 currently enrolled on Medicaid.

Prenatal to 5 (0–5) Home Visitation Program: Home visits by certified infant development Registered Nurses. Referral required. (No fee).

Nurse-Family Partnership: Free home visits by Registered Nurses for first-time pregnant women throughout pregnancy which continues until babies reach 2 years of age.

Immigration Medical Exam: Medical examinations and immunizations provided for U.S. immigration requirements. By appointment only.
