Dear Mr. Williams:

This letter is in response to your GRAMA request dated February 14, 2017 in which you requested the following records:

Audit working papers for fire station construction cost and unathorized [sic] budget adjustments, as identified in Report No. SSVF-17-SPa.

Your request is denied because the records have been classified as protected records pursuant to Utah Code § 63G-2-305(10)(a) & (b). The records were received or created for audit purposes, and release of the records at this time "reasonably could be expected to interfere with investigations undertaken for enforcement, discipline, licensing, certification, or registration purposes" or "reasonably could be expected to interfere with audits, disciplinary, or enforcement proceedings."

Pursuant to Utah Code § 63G-2-401, you have the right to appeal the denial of this request to the chief administrative officer, John Dougall, Utah State Auditor. Your notice of appeal must be submitted within 30 days of the above denial date and must include your name, mailing address, daytime telephone number, and an explanation of the relief sought. You may also include any supporting information with your notice of appeal. Your appeal may be submitted at the address listed below.

Please be aware that all GRAMA requests are posted on our website as a matter of office practice (with personal information, such as address, redacted). We do this to provide transparency and accountability to the public at large.
