Dear Ms. Penrod:

This letter is in response to your GRAMA request dated May 16, 2017 in which you requested the following records:

Hotel invoices submitted for reimbursement by a former employee of the state Division of Water Quality between July 2006 and October 2016, and reviewed by the auditor's office during the preparation of report No. DEQ-17-SP.

Your request is denied because the records you have requested are records that were received by the Office from another Utah governmental entity pursuant to Utah Code § 63G-2-206(1)(c), and the Office is not authorized to disclose another governmental entity's records. You may request those records from the Department of Environmental Quality at 195 North 1950 West, Salt Lake City, Utah 84114-4810. See also, Utah Code § 63G-2-204(2)(b).

Pursuant to Utah Code § 63G-2-401, you have the right to appeal the denial of this request to the chief administrative officer, John Dougall, Utah State Auditor. Your notice of appeal must be submitted within 30 days of the above denial date and must include your name, mailing address, daytime telephone number, and an explanation of the relief sought. You may also include any supporting information with your notice of appeal. Your appeal may be submitted at the address listed below or jdougall@utah.gov.

Please be aware that all GRAMA requests are posted on our website as a matter of office practice (with personal information, such as address, redacted). We do this to provide transparency and accountability to the public at large.
