



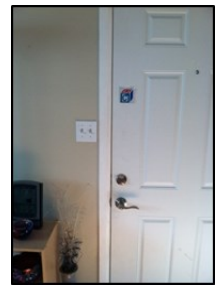
Children's Health Information Red Pack (CHIRP)

What happens once we enroll?

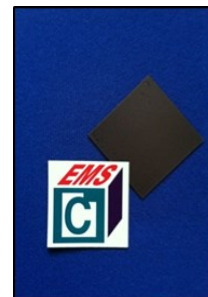
- Your information will be reviewed by the EMSC Pediatric Clinical Consultant RN.
- You should review your Health Information Sheet for accuracy.
- Place one copy in each of the two vials sent to you.
 - ⇒ One to be kept with your child at all times
 - ⇒ The other to go in the door of the refrigerator or freezer where the child resides.
- Place the EMSC magnet on the fridge/freezer containing the information sheet.
- Place the EMSC sticker on the inside of your main entry door as a signal to EMS to look in the fridge.
- Update and replace the information in these vials at least every 6 months or as needed.
- We will give you the contact information for your local EMS agencies, we encourage you to contact and educate them on your child's needs



Parents are sent two vials to keep up-to-date medical info in. One to stay with the child in the red bag, the other to be kept in the fridge of the child's home



Place the EMSC sticker on the inside of the door, signaling that up-to-date medical info is kept in a vial in the fridge



The magnet is placed on the fridge containing the vial
