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Approval of minutes:	Kris Kemp asked for the approval of minutes.	Jason Nicholl motioned to approve the minutes, Russell Bradley seconded the motion, none opposed, none abstained. Motion carries.
Rule Amendments for New Designation (HB 322) and Training (R426-1, R426-2, R426-4, R426-5)	Guy Dansie reviewed the "secure transport" proposed rule and definitions (R426-1). • The workgroup came up with the definitions and then it was taken to the EMS Rules Taskforce. Change on the IV admission and patient-operated oxygen and the nonemergency secured transport. Guy Dansie discussed the issue of the timeliness of this rule and feels there is an issue to get this rule in place, however, we recognize that there are several areas that are not addressed in this rule, the policies and we want to develop an algorithm for the physicians who do the discharge of these patients. Now that the law has been vetoed, the deadline is not as quick. However, we want to get something defined for what is best for our providers. (R426-5) Guy Dansie discusses the changes on this rule. Wants to move this out to public comment at this time.	Mike Mathieu motions to defer the decision on this rule proposal pending recommendations from the Rules Taskforce reconvening and the bureau identifying whether there are any other stakeholders that would want to be invited to help develop this rule until this taskforce feels the rule is ready for consideration. Seconded by Jay Dee Downs, none opposed, none abstained. Motion carries. Jason Nicholl makes a motion to accept the rules
		as written with the exception of "R426-5-1000 to read "individuals applying for "EMR, EMT, AEMT or Paramedic licensure" may also be

		required to successfully pass the departments written examination" and accept all the others as written". Mike Moffitt seconded the motion. None opposed, none abstained. Motion carries.
