A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A PORTION OF THE STATE OF UTAH'S FIRE RESTRICTION ORDER

WHEREAS, the State of Utah released a fire restriction order effective at 12:01 a.m. on the 14th of June, 2012, pursuant to the Utah State Law, Section 65A08-212 Utah Code 1994; and

WHEREAS, the Myton City Mayor and City Council feel it is in the best interest and safety of the resident of the City;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Myton City, State of Utah as of June 28, 2012, Myton City and its residents will abide by the State of Utah's Fire Restriction Order Sections 1, 3, and 4 and any violation of the above prohibited acts is punishable as a Class B misdemeanor.

A copy of the order and the sections that are restricted in Myton City are attached to this resolution. This resolution will be in effect until the City Council releases the fire restriction order.

Fire Restriction Order

Due to current and forecasted weather conditions coupled with the extremely dry condition and heavy loading of vegetation throughout the State of Utah, the State Forester has determined that measures must be taken to prevent costly and damaging forest and rangeland fires. Therefore, pursuant to Utah State Law, Section 65A-8-212 Utah Code 1994, the following acts are prohibited on the areas, roads and trails described below until rescinded by the Utah State Forester:

1. Setting, building, maintaining, attending or using open fires of any kind, except campfires built within the facilities provided for them in improved campgrounds, picnic areas or permanently improved places of habitation.
2. Smoking, except within an enclosed vehicle or building, a developed recreation site or while stopped in an area at least three feet in diameter that is barren or cleared to mineral soil.
3. Discharging, or using any kind of fireworks, tracer ammunition or other pyrotechnic devices.
4. Cutting, welding, or grinding metal in areas of dry vegetation.

The following persons are exempted from the above prohibitions:


1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the prohibited act at a specific location.
2. Any State or Federal Fire Officer or firefighting forces in the performance of an official duty.

Area Description:

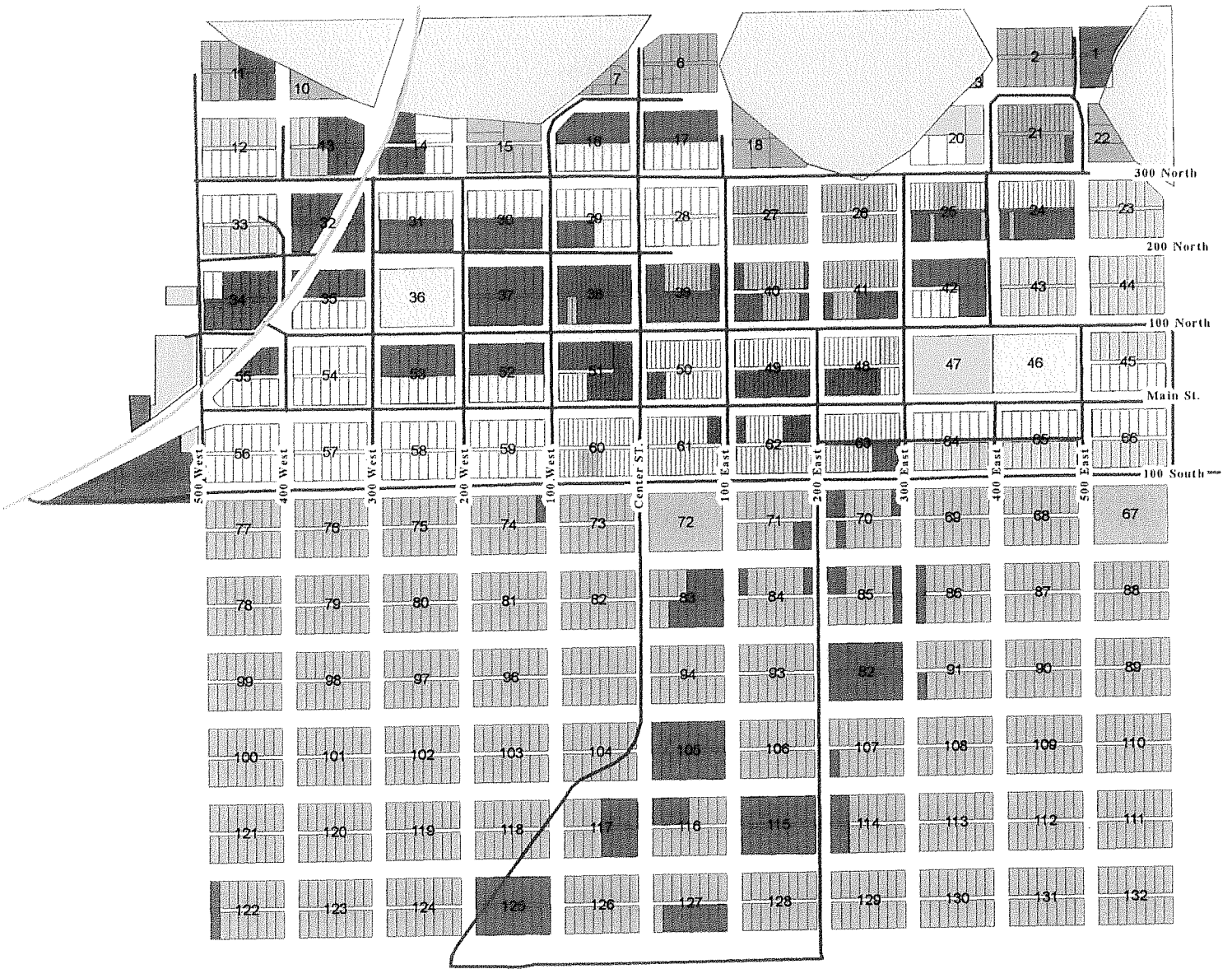
All unincorporated private and state lands within the State of Utah.
This order does not affect incorporated towns and cities.

Effective 12:01 A.M., 14th day of June, 2012.

Violation of the above prohibited acts is punishable as a class B misdemeanor.
