

Utah Code - Public Safety Code 53-7-225.1 - Civil Liability:

1) (a) An individual who negligently, recklessly, or intentionally causes or spreads a fire through discharge of a class C explosive is liable for the cost of suppressing that fire and any damages the fire causes.



2018 FIREWORKS SALES AND DISCHARGE DATES

Sales

Class "C" fireworks can be sold the following dates:

June 24 – July 25
December 29 – December 31st
2 days before and on Chinese New Year's Eve

Discharge

Between the hours of 11am and 11pm except as noted:

July 2 – July 5
(July 4 hours extended to midnight)

July 22 – 25
(July 24 hours extended to midnight)

December 31*
(11am – 1am Jan. 1)

Chinese New Year's Eve
(11am – 1am the following day)

*if New Year's eve is on a Sunday and the county, municipality, or metro township determines to celebrate New Year's eve on the prior Saturday (Dec 30), then a person may discharge Class C common state approved explosives on that prior Saturday within the county, municipality, or metro township;
