

Don't Cheat the HOV

Violation of Utah's Express Lanes (also known as high-occupancy vehicle lanes, or HOV) causes unnecessary slowdowns and congestion. To maximize the efficiency of the Express Lanes and the entire I-15 corridor, follow the rules



Don't cross the double white lines--it's unsafe and illegal. Don't weave in and out--enter and exit at designated areas indicated by white-dotted lines

Trooper Shout-Outs and Reports:

- Sgt. Spillman cited a driver, whose license was revoked, for an ignition interlock violation and the vehicle was impounded.
- Trooper Fawson made 4.25 stops per hour during a 4hour HOV overtime shift.



- Trooper Tucker made 4 stops per hour during a 4-hour HOV overtime shift.
- Trooper Alexander worked 2 HOV overtime shifts and averaged 3.9 stops per hour.
- Trooper Wurtz worked 3 HOV overtime shifts and averaged 3.5 stops per hour.
- Sgt. Rumfield made 3.25 stops per hour during a 4-hour HOV overtime shift.
- Sgt. Weber made 3.2 stops per hour during a 5-hour HOV overtime shift.
- Trooper Fairbourn made 3 stops per hour during a 4hour HOV overtime shift.
- Trooper Powell made 3 stops per hour during a 4-hour HOV overtime shift, and also stopped a driver trying to flee the traffic stop.
- One trooper commented about the challenge of HOV enforcement as most of the vehicles he stopped had small children in the backseat who he could not see.
