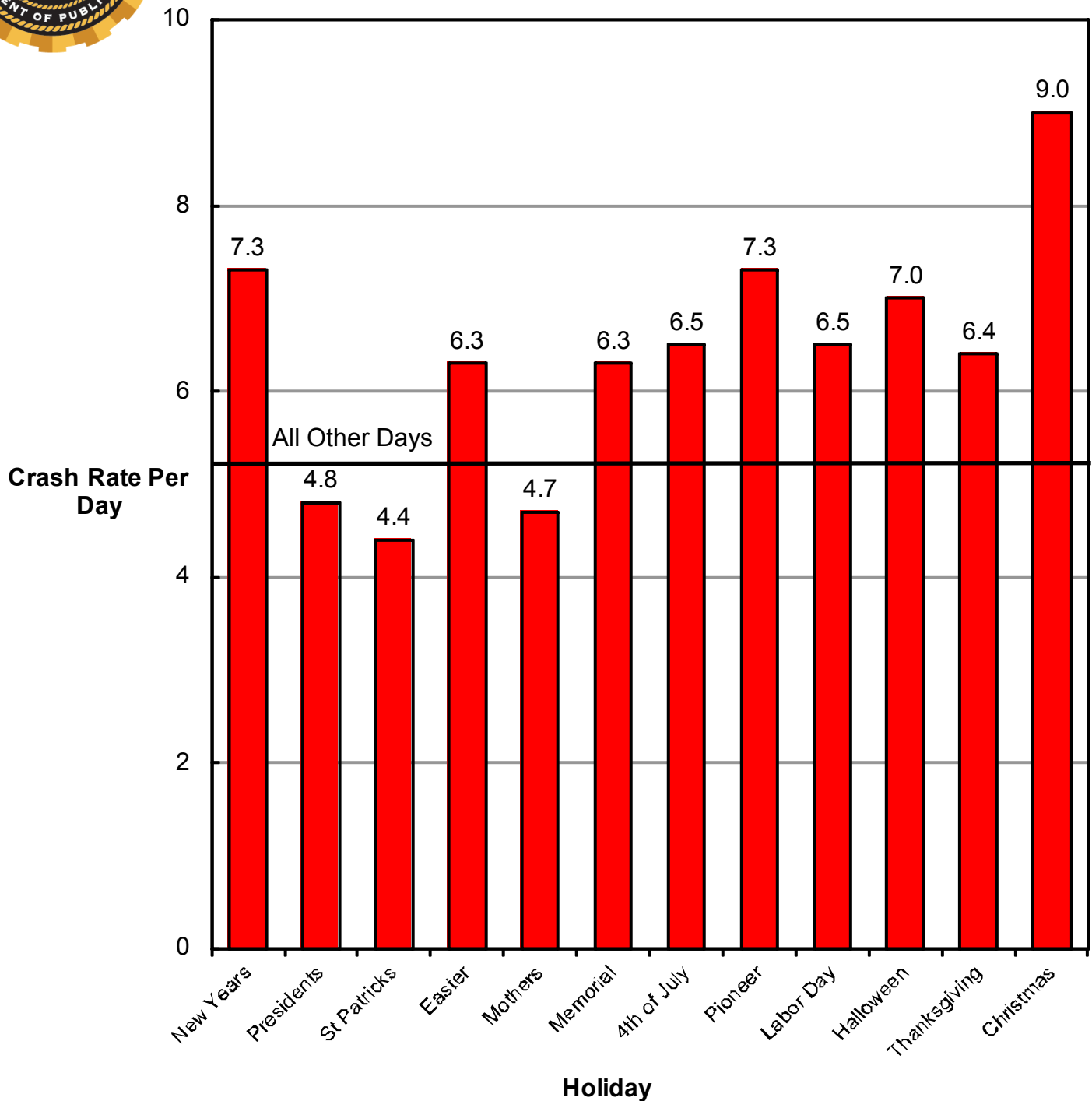




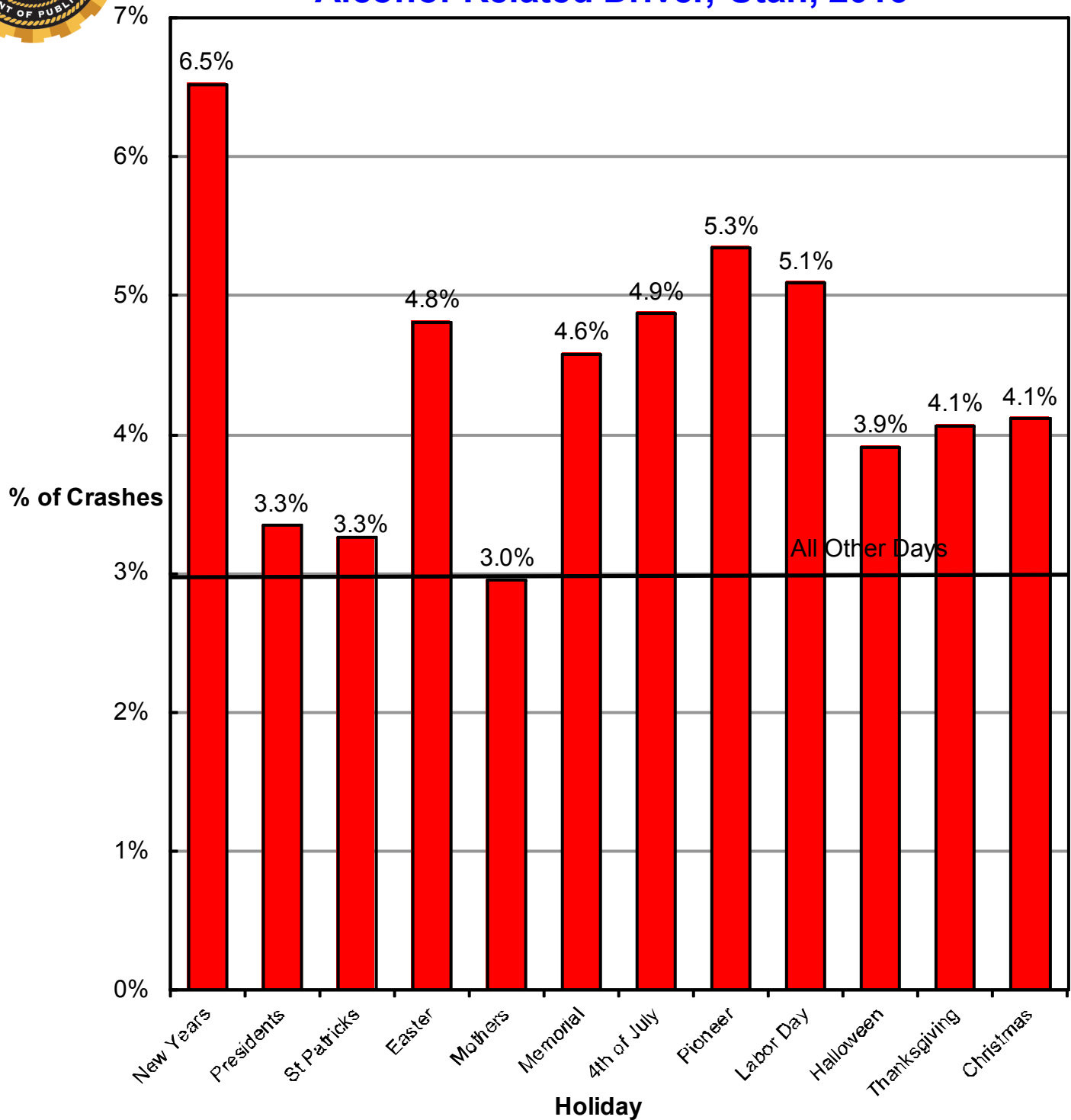
Holiday Crashes Involving an Alcohol-Related Driver, Utah, 2016



- The Christmas (9.0), New Years (7.3), and Pioneer Day (7.3) Holidays had the highest rate of alcohol-related driver crashes in 2016.
- The St. Patrick's Day (4.4), Mother's Day (4.7), and President's Day(4.8) Holidays had the lowest rate of alcohol-related driver crashes in 2016.
- Holiday crashes had a higher rate of alcohol-related driver crashes than other days of the year— 6.3 compared to 5.3 crashes per day.



% of Holiday Crashes Involving an Alcohol-Related Driver, Utah, 2016



- The New Years (6.5%), Pioneer (5.3%), and Labor Day (5.1%) Holidays had the highest percent of crashes involving alcohol-related drivers in 2016.
- The Mother's Day (3.0%), President's Day (3.3%), and St. Patrick's Day (3.3%) Holidays had the lowest percent of crashes involving alcohol-related drivers in 2016.
- Holiday crashes had a higher percent of crashes involving alcohol-related drivers than other days of the year—4.3% compared to 3.0% crashes per day.
