

Vendor Information for Camp Floyd State Park's Day of the Cowboy July 26-27, 2019

Camp Floyd State Park was home to the United States Army, Mormon Pioneers, Stagecoach Travelers, and the Pony Express. The Army arrived in 1858 and constructed Camp Floyd to suppress a supposed Mormon rebellion. The Army remained here for three years before being recalled for the Civil War. Today, Camp Floyd State Park features three structures and a cemetery. Visitors can visit the museum and Stagecoach Inn and learn about this nationally important historic site.

For Camp Floyd State Park's Day of the Cowboy we are looking for vendors with a Western, Cowboy, Cowgirl, Country or Historic theme to enhance the show. Crafts, art, clothing, hats, boots, tack, leatherwork, quilting, silversmiths, etc. but all vendors will be considered. Those vendors accepted for Camp Floyd State Park's Day of the Cowboy will be contacted directly.

<u>Each day vendors are expected to remain open from 10:00 am - 5:00 pm unless arrangements have been made with the park manager.</u>

The vendor fee is \$100 for this year for the 2 days. For the returning vendors from last year a 20% discount applies.

Set up time will be from 7:00am - 10:00 am.

Keep in mind this is an outdoor show! You will need to provide your own shelter. Power may be available upon request.

Vendor Checklist:

- Temporary Food Establishment Permits.
 Individuals seeking a permit to sell food at a one-time event may obtain a temporary permit. Permits must be obtained from Utah County.
- Vendors are responsible to pay all appropriate taxes on revenue from Camp Floyd State Park's Day of the Cowboy
