

Utah State Parks 2019 Spring OHV Photo Contest

Rules:

1. **ENTRY:** Contestants may enter by submitting a photo to the Utah State Parks OHV Program official Facebook page: <https://www.facebook.com/UtahStateParksOHVProgram/> from March 15 to March 22, 2019. Entries submitted after March 22 will not be eligible for the contest. Vetted photos will be moved into the dedicated album in the photos section. Submissions may also be shared on the Utah State Parks website, on our Facebook pages, and elsewhere on the web.

2. **ELIGIBILITY:** Photo submissions must be taken by the person submitting the photo. Only one photo per person will be accepted. The photo must have been taken in Utah and feature an Off-Highway Vehicle to be eligible. Constants are required to include the location where the photo was taken when they submit the photo. We will not accept any photos featuring vulgar, sexually explicit, or graphic content. You may edit your photo for brightness, contrast, saturation, etc. However, photos may not be edited to an extent that the content is changed (i.e. adding in objects or people that were not in the original photo). No Utah State Parks employees or their family members may participate in this contest.

3. **WINNER SELECTION:** The winner of the contest will be chosen by ranking the number of “likes” and/or “reactions” each photo receives throughout the voting period. Only the likes/reactions on the official OHV Facebook page photos will count. The voting period will be March 25–April 1, 2019. The photo with the most on the OHV Facebook page will be awarded first place.

4. **PRIZES:** The first-place winner will receive one Utah State Parks annual pass.

5. **WINNER NOTIFICATION:** The winner will be announced on Friday, April 5, 2019, on the OHV Facebook page. Winners will be notified within 14 days after the announcement via Facebook message to the account that submitted the photo. Inability to contact a winner may result in disqualification and selection of an alternate winner, who would be chosen using the original criteria.

6. GENERAL CONDITIONS:

a. Participants hereby grant Utah State Parks permission to broadcast, publish, store, reproduce, distribute, and otherwise use and exhibit the submission, along with their names and/or likenesses, in all media now known and later come into being for purposes of trade or advertising without further compensation. Participants represent and warrant that they have full legal right, power, and authority to grant Utah State Parks the foregoing license and if applicable, have secured all necessary rights from any participants in, and contributors to, their submission in order to grant such a license.

b. Utah State Parks is under no obligation to use or post any submission.

7. **USE OF CONTEST INFORMATION:** Utah State Parks reserves the right to use any and all information related to the contest, including submissions provided by the contestants, for editorial, marketing, and any other purpose, unless prohibited by law.

8. **NOT ENDORSED BY FACEBOOK:** By participating in this contest, you acknowledge that this contest is in no way sponsored, endorsed or administered by, or associated with, Facebook and release Facebook from any and all liability arising from or related to this contest.

9. **CONDUCT:** All contest participants agree to be bound by these official rules. Utah State Parks, in its sole discretion, reserves the right to disqualify any person it finds to be tampering with the entry process, the operation of its website, or who is otherwise in violation of these rules.

10. **LIMITATIONS OF LIABILITY:** Utah State Parks is not responsible for late, lost, or misdirected submissions, nor for any computer, online, telephone, or technical malfunctions that may occur. Utah State Parks reserves the right to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the contest for any reason. Entrants further agree to release Utah from any liability resulting from or related to participation in the contest.

11. **WINNERS LIST:** The names of the winners will be released to the media and posted on the Utah State Parks website and official Utah State Parks Facebook page, and will be shared with the Facebook accounts of all participants.
