ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS OF SPECIAL USE PERMIT

- 12. PERMITTEE will follow all park rules and regulations, wildlife regulations, and state laws. Vehicles are confined to roads and parking lots. PERMITTEE will be responsible for following all boating regulations. This includes, but is not limited to, personal floatation device (PFD), registration, insurance, and safety equipment requirements.
- 13. PERMITTEE is responsible for drone and any damages.
- 14. No filming of people not associated with your group.
- 15. No filming of any dam or its structures.
- 16. If any unsafe conditions or failure to comply to the Special Use Permit arise, a park employee may terminate operation of the drone.
- 17. PERMITTEE must comply with all FAA Small Unmanned Aircraft Rules.
- 18. Fees associated with this permit include park impact fees, entrance into the park during the shoot, and minimal staff assistance if requested.
- 19. Any park damage sustained by PERMITTEE will be the responsibility of the PERMITTEE to repair to its original condition or better.
- 20. Any activities not mentioned in this permit must receive prior written approval by Park Manager and additional fees and conditions may apply.
- 21. Commercial filming must be disclosed in advance. Commercial filming requires Remote Pilot Certificate and UAS Certificate. Copies of certificates must be provided.

22. FOR BOR PARKS:

For safety and security reasons, drone use is not permitted within 2,000 feet of a dam or its appurtenant facilities or within the Primary Jurisdiction Zone (PJZ) as outlined in the detailed map, whichever distance is greater. Anyone flying drones within those restricted areas will be prosecuted to the fullest extent of the law.

All commercial filming and photography must receive approved permit from the Bureau of Reclamation and attached to completed SUP permit to be valid. Permits must be completed before any PERMITTEE activity may take place.
