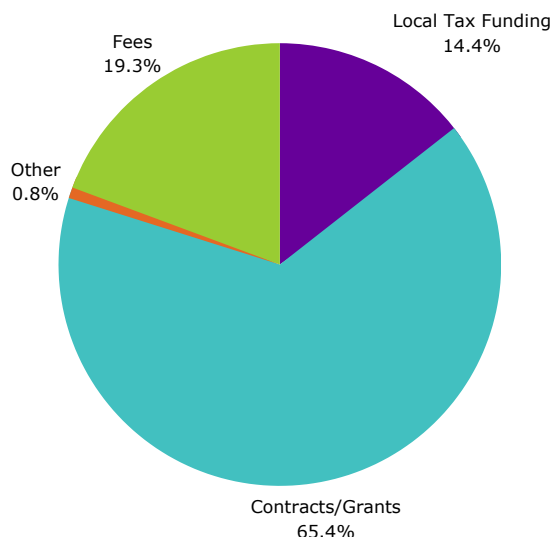

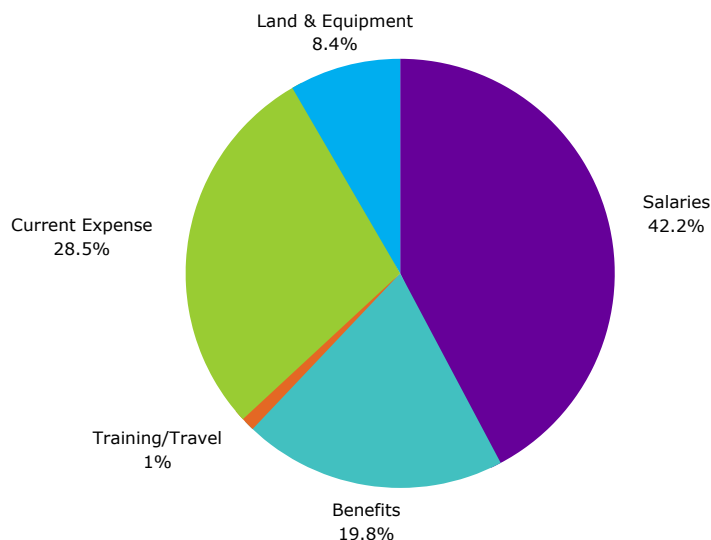
Revenue
